- Employees of the Louis Riel School Division receive a newsletter called The Riel Citizen. The October 2014 issue speaks to the United Way in LRSD. In 2013/2014 the division raised \$98,459!! Louis Riel School Division had a 30.6% participation, which was the highest contribution per capita of any school division in metro Winnipeg. This year the Board Office staff has increased their donations, and last year Victor Mager School had 80.4% participation while this year they have 100% participation! This is terrific news!
