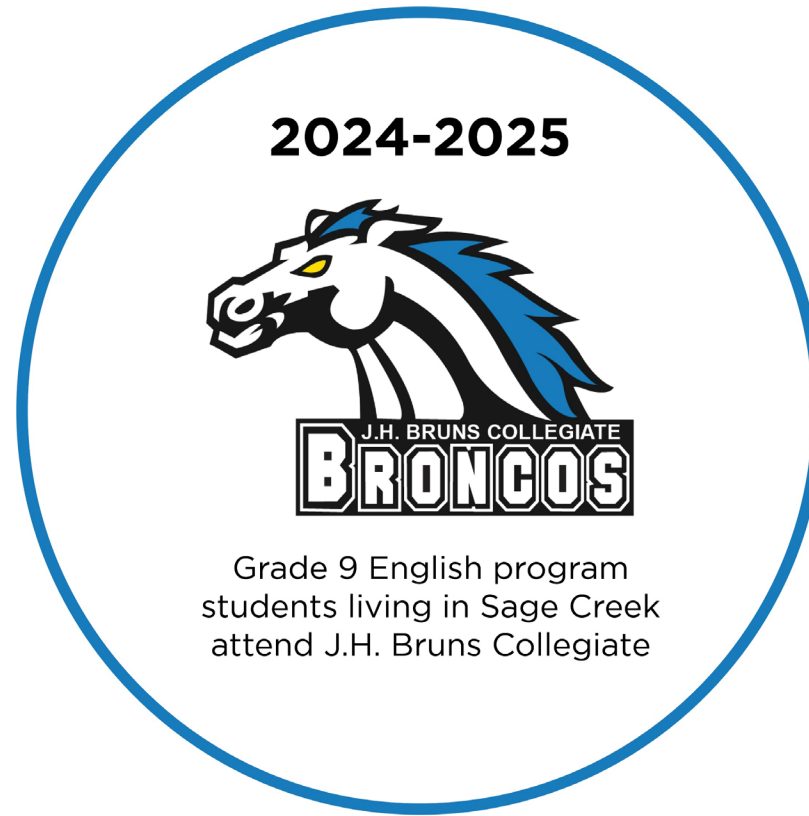

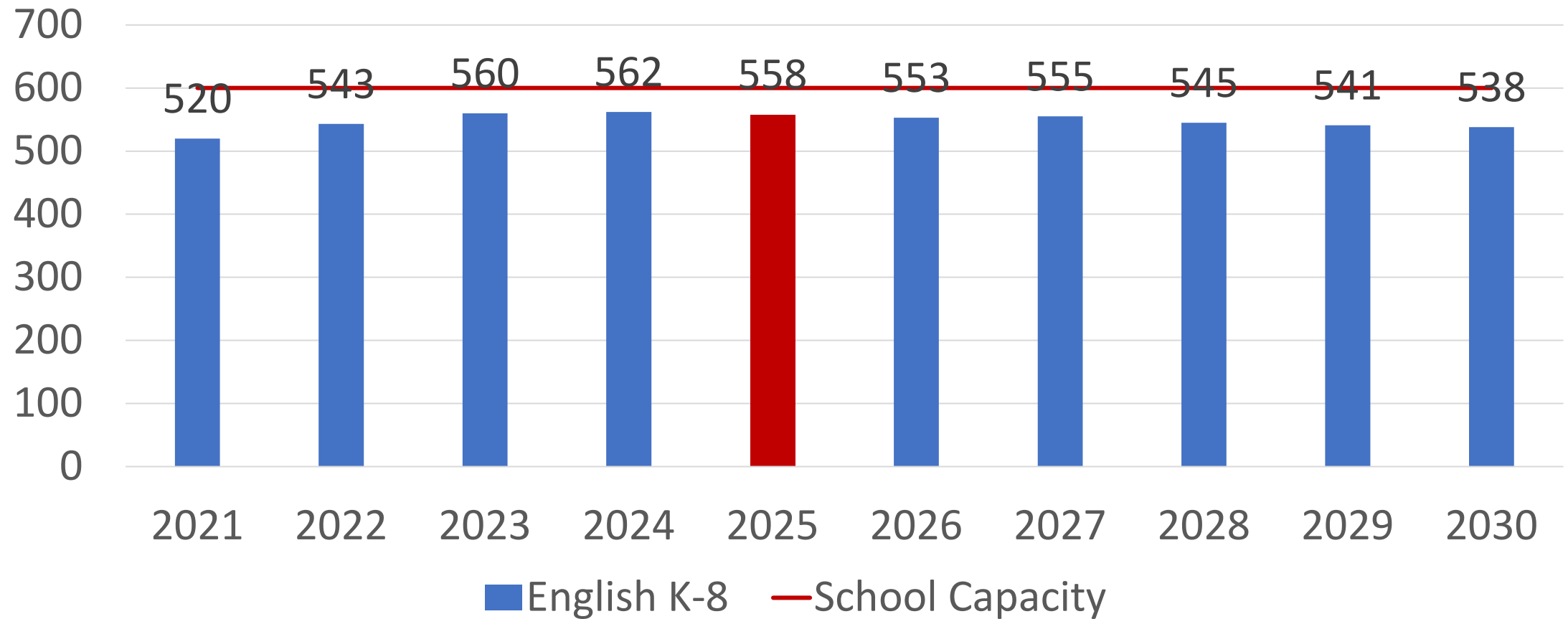


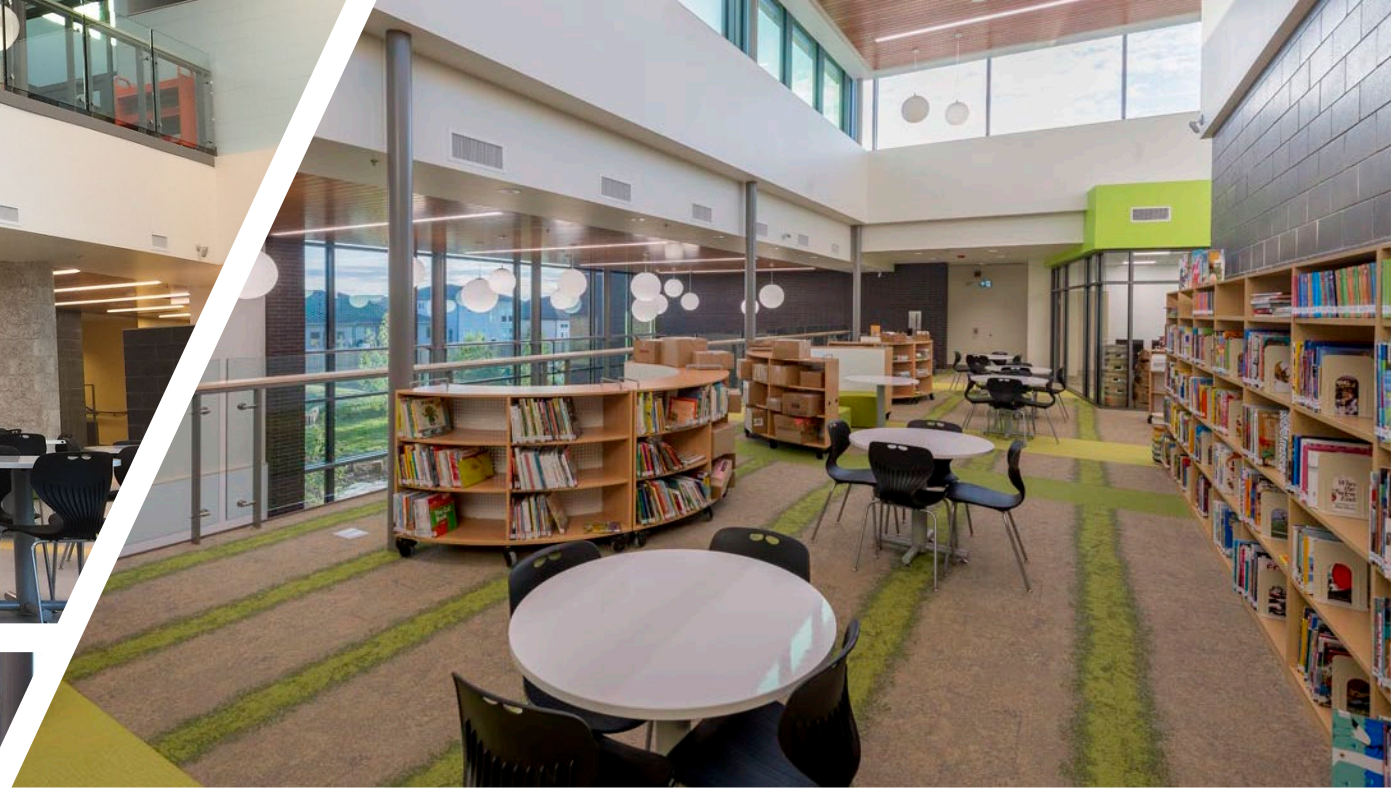

# English Program Enrolment Projection

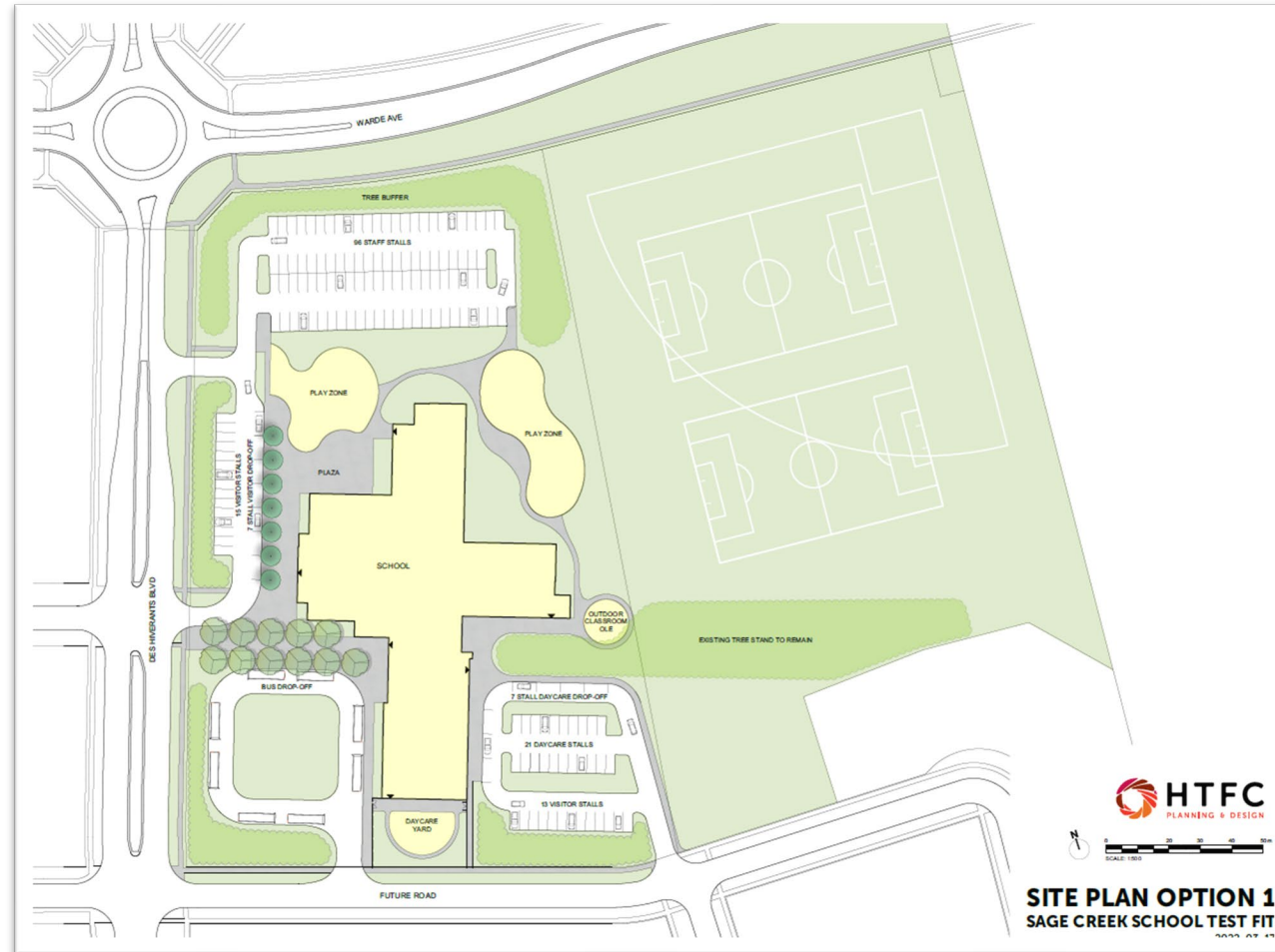






# Two Schools in Sage Creek by 2025-2026

# Location of the New School

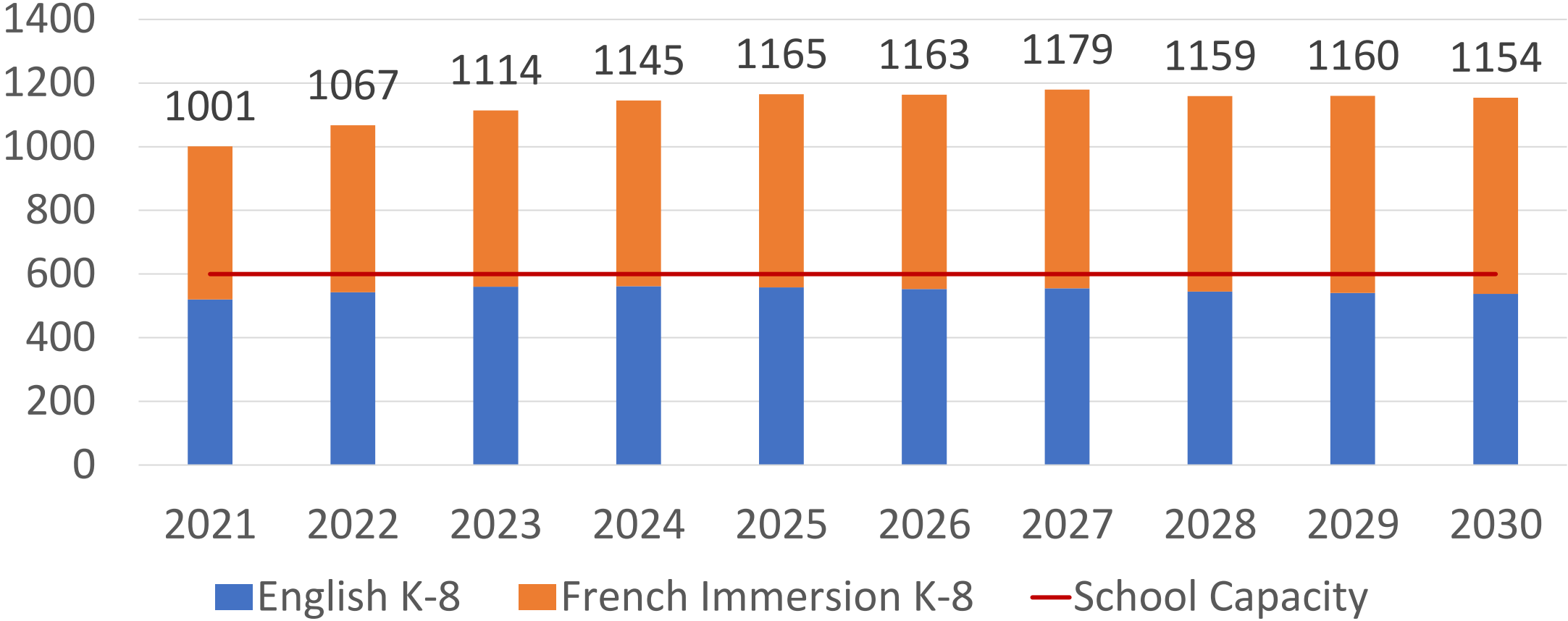


Existing School

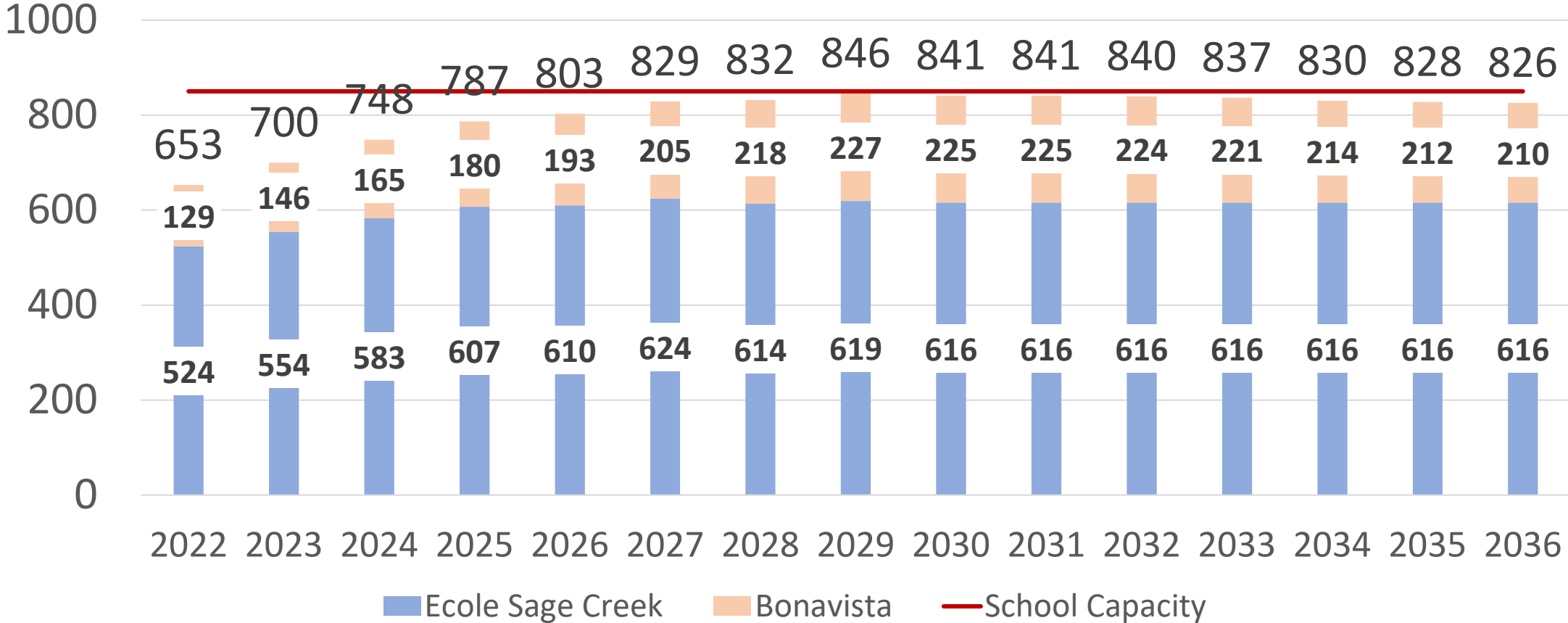
New School

# French Immersion Projection

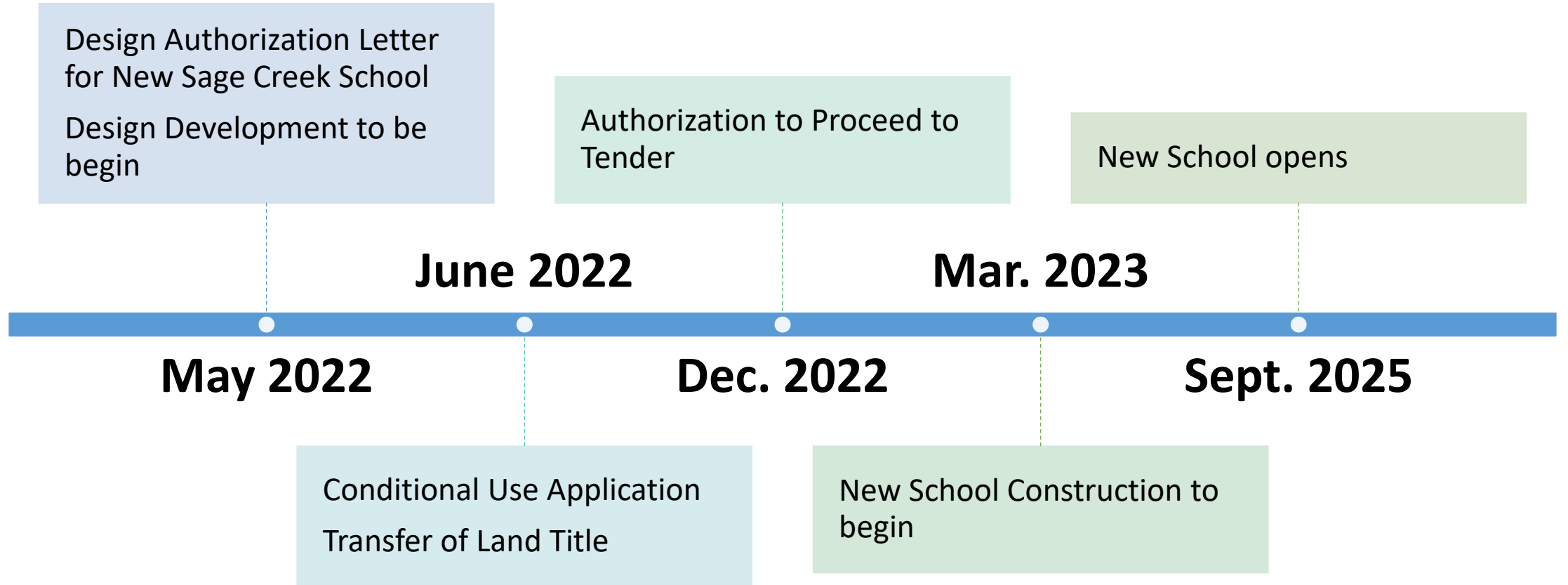
