






## Why would I want access to myBlueprint Education Planner?

The brand new family account allows you to view student artifacts and reflections, including the goals they are setting, occupations they are interested in, and what they are learning in school.

You can log in to your account to comment on your child's work or receive messages from their teacher(s).

#### How does my child login to myBlueprint?

- 1. Visit www.myBlueprint.ca
- 2. Click Log In
- 3. Enter username and password
  - \*Want them to send you an invitation? Have them click their Name and select My Links.

#### **How do I create my Family Account?**

- 1. Visit www.myBlueprint.ca/lrsd
- 2. Click Sign Up
- 3. Select your child's **High School** (or their future high school)
- 4. Select Family
- 5. Fill out the sign up form and click Create Account

#### How do I link to my child?

- 1. Click +Add Student
- 2. Enter the email your child used when they created their myBlueprint account
- 3. Select Add Student
  - \*Students can approve your link request by clicking on their name and selecting My Links.
