- Q: With Sage Creek being the only school joining CB next year, will there still be grade 7/8 mixed grade classes?

Q: What plans are there during/for Black History Month?

A: There are many activities planned:

Black History Month at CB – February 2022

- Every morning, a student from the Leadership class will read a fact relating to Black History Month after the Land Acknowledgement and National Anthem. This information is also posted to the morning announcements for teachers to project on the white board.
- 2. Music from different Black musicians has been playing in the hallways before the start of the school day and during the lunch hour.
- 3. Monday February 7th Discovery Activity about Black History Month:

 Teachers were asked to do the following with at least one of their classes: with students, take 15 minutes to learn about a well known black person in your subject area. (in chemistry, history, as an athlete, etc...) Identify someone, or a concept or a technology and find a way to help others learn about this discovery. Prepare a poster, print off some material, prepare a power point slide, write something on the window of your classroom, etc...
- 4. Wednesday February 9th from 2 to 2:45 pm: Virtual Zoom Field Trip: Black History in Canada (Black History Manitoba and Manitoba Museum) for all Grade 7 to 12 students.
- 5. **Monday February 28th** The committee will possibly organize a Kahoot (PEP class) for all students about the facts that were shared throughout the month.
