

Children learn through discovering their world, in a safe, loving environment and through

Bright Minds Program is designed to promote independence and social skills that will foster learning experiences and self confidence in each child.

Our Program is geared towards teaching children about sharing, taking turns and respecting each other. We will assist children to develop their gross motor skills by engaging them in activities that requires running, jumping and climbing. Fine motor skills are also a focus point where children are engaged in tracing, coloring and cutting.
