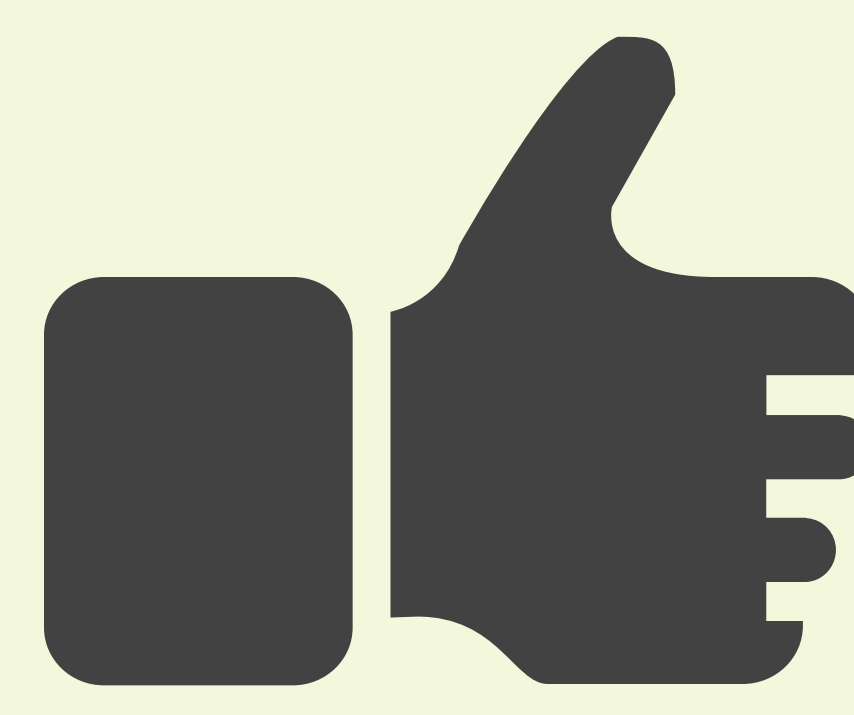

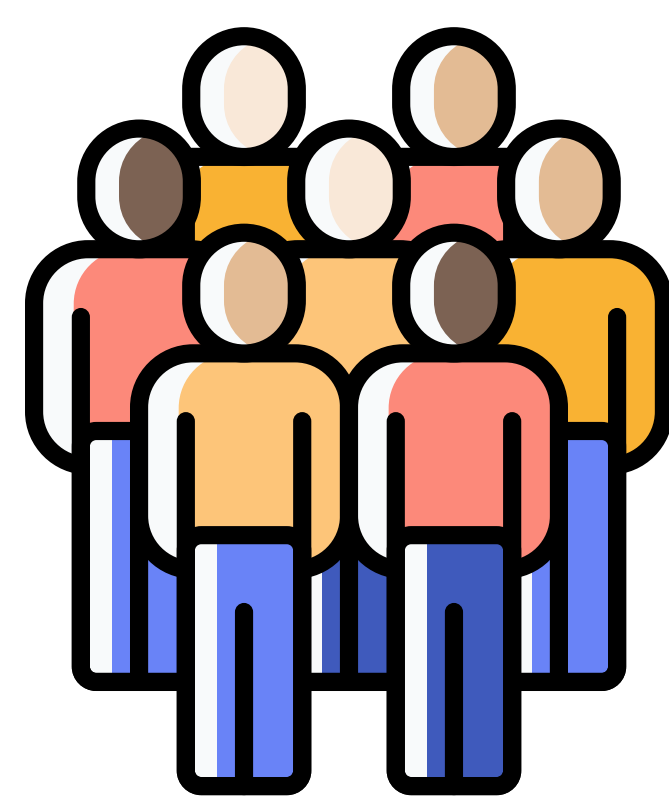
Self-Regulation

Literacy

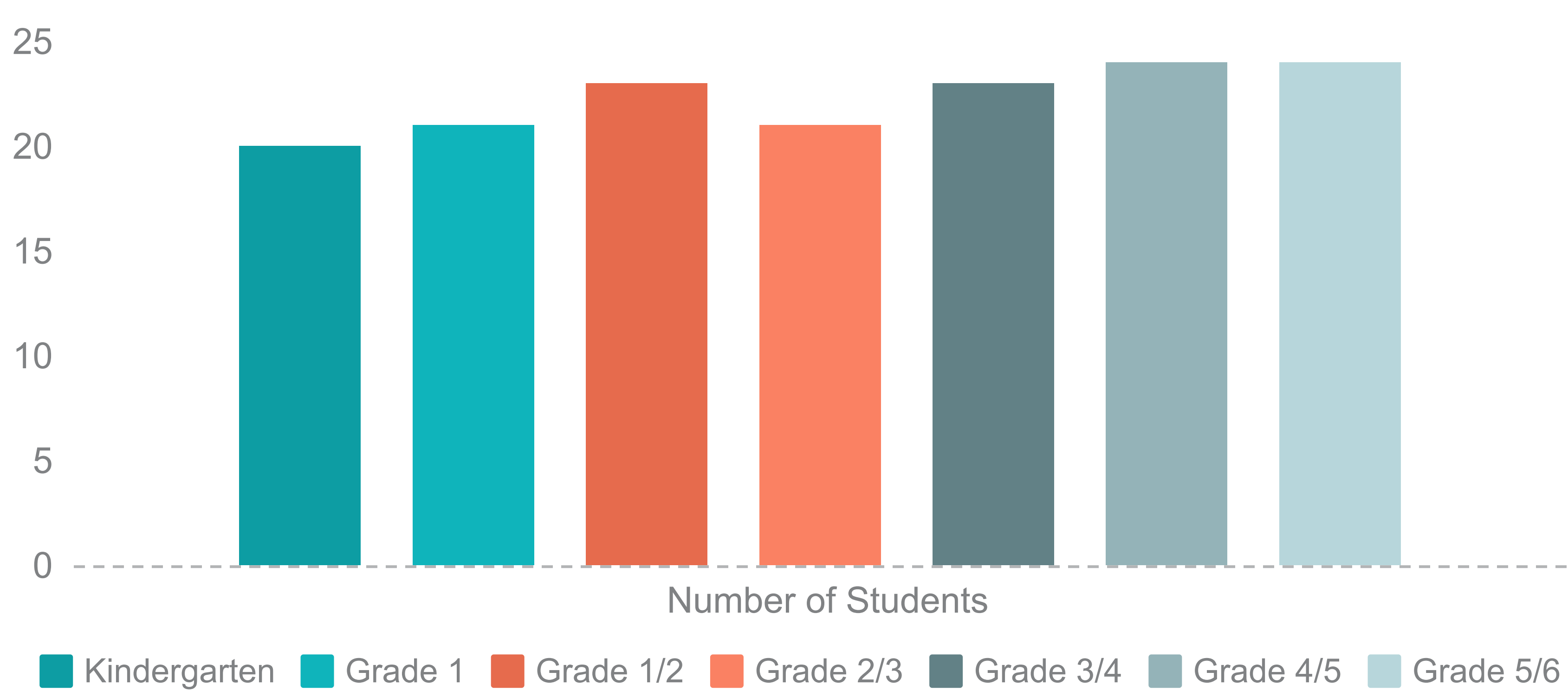

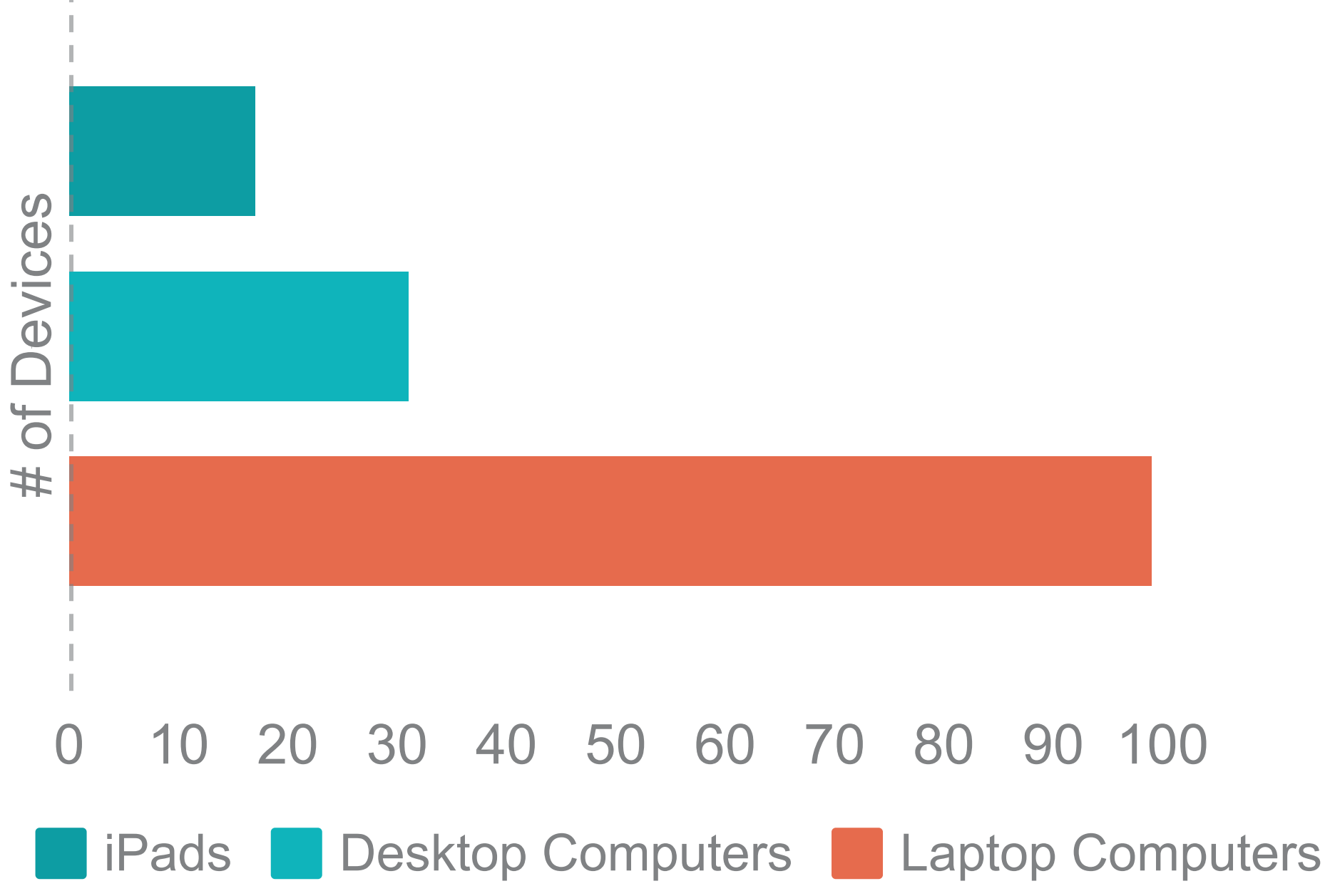
Belonging

Class Configurations 2018-2019



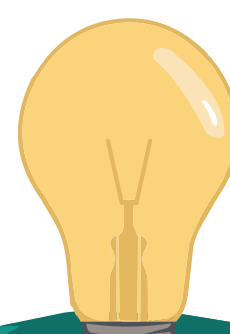

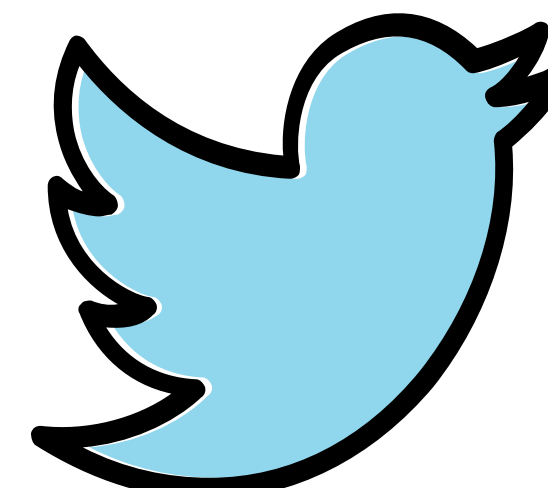
