GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS


- 30 credits are required to graduate
- All 17 compulsory credits must be completed
- Min. 5 credits at the Grade 11 level for graduation
- Min. 5 credits at the Grade 12 level for graduation
- 6 credits at the Grade 12 level for University Entrance requirements
 - Minimum three 40S credits are needed
 - Different universities have different "approved" credits

Essential Math 30S

Prepares students with the mathematical tools and skills for the real world.

Applied Math 30S

- You will be most successful if your grade 10 Intro to Applied and Pre-Cal Math mark is at least 70%
- Talk with your current math teacher about whether this option might be right for you.
- Is designed for students who plan further study in mathematics as part of their post-secondary education.
- Useful for many post-secondary options, including most university faculties and college programs.

Pre-Calculus Math 30S

- You will be most successful if your grade 10 Intro to Applied and Pre-Cal Math mark is at least 75%
- Talk with your current math teacher about whether this option might be right for you.
- Is designed for students who plan further study in mathematics as part of their post-secondary education.
