Important Notes:

- \$90 Student Fee due at start of the next school year (payment online or in the office by cash or cheque only)
- Grade nine students must take 9 courses (6 comp. and 3 elec.)
- Grade ten students must take 8 courses (5 comp. and 3 elec.)
- Grade eleven students must take 7 courses (4 comp. and 3 elec.)
- Grade twelve students must take at least 6 courses and/or the needed courses to graduate.

• All compulsory courses after grade nine have prerequisites. You must finish the previous grade to advance to the next level. Many electives also have prerequisites. Please see the online handbook for more details.

• \*\*Additional Elective Courses are scheduled at noon or after school and are taken in addition to a student's regular course load and may have an associated fee to take the course.

• \*Have an associated fee to take the course, payable on the first day of classes to the office or online.

• Students wishing to take courses at ATC must also complete an additional application. Students must still register for a regular course load as not all students are accepted into ATC. LRSD students who will be attending ATC, please note that the \$90 student fee must be paid at Windsor Park Collegiate. If you are issued a statement of fees by ATC for uniforms, food safe, coveralls, kits or other fees, those fees must be paid directly to ATC.
