• PARENT QUESTIONS

- A parent asked if there would be a student council this year, and if so, what grades would be included to participate in it. Mme. Kolody noted she would check.
- A parent asked what was being done to address vaping in the school. Mme.
 Kolody indicated that a program by the Manitoba Lung Association was being planned to present to the student body.
- A parent asked if there would be an update on the plans for the school to move to the new location. There was agreement that the community in general is asking for an update on these plans. Mms. Kolody noted that a meeting is being held with the school division this week and she will ask for an update to provide to families and the community.
- A parent asked if the school is doing the "soiree d'excellence" this year. Mme.
 Oldfield said the school is looking at options to do something that may be slightly different, and will update families when more information in known.
- A parent asked when yearbooks would be distributed. The target date is anticipated to be Friday, September 20 (or soon thereafter).
- A parent raised concerns about the accessibility/inclusiveness of sports

opportunities for all students, particularly those who may not have access to transportation or the ability to pay participation fees. Discussion included options for students to access transportation from other participants/coaches. Mme. Kolody noted that the school is open to discussing options with families that may face barriers with paying sports fees.
