- Construction Update
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> floor done. Moving in Semester 2. Teacher's to start moving in next week, furniture moves. ELA, Social Studies, Tech, Spanish will move to the second floor. Feb 5<sup>th</sup> moving day. Nice breakout space with additional seating.
  - Old band room to be new fitness centre (working on currently).
    Expect to be completed by end of Spring Break. Will be a supervised space. Will include bathroom/ shower / storage space.
  - External work in the Spring (parking space, landscaping/tree planting). Started conversations with the City, Province and Dakota field replacement for a multipurpose field (planning for a soccer pitch size space with artificial turf). Interested in bringing in Lacross, Field Hockey, other. Subject to negotiations, work could begin summer 2024.
