


## Parent Portal – view Report Cards


Report cards, high school transcripts, and tax receipts are published to the Student Portfolio within the Parent Portal.

To access your child's report card using a browser on a computer:


1. Login to the Tyler SIS side of the LRSD Parent Portal - <https://tyler360.lrsd.net>



2. Select the Student Portfolio option from the menu on the left



3. The list of Student Portfolio documents will display.
4. Click on the desired report card to view it.
  - a. If you are looking for a report card from a previous year, select the desired year under the Academic Year dropdown menu on the Home screen.




- b. Note: The Academic Year is listed in a shortened format – for example, the 2019-2020 school year is listed as 1920.


### To access your child’s report card using a mobile device

Report cards may not display correctly in the browser of a smartphone or iPad. To view a report card on a mobile device, you will need to use the free Tyler SIS Student 360 application.


1. Search for Tyler SIS in the Play Store/App Store
2. Select the Tyler SIS Student 360 app – ensure it is from the developer Tyler Technologies Inc.




3. Download, then open the app
4. You will be prompted to select the school district – type in Louis Riel or R2M 3R3 to locate the Louis Riel School Division



5. Tap the Louis Riel School Division to select that.
6. The login screen will then display, login with your Parent Portal username and password




7. The Parent Portal will then display for your child.



- a. If you have multiple students associated with your Parent Portal account, click the ☰ menu in the top left corner, then tap the name of the student under Select Student to change students.

8. To view the report card, click the ☰ menu in the top left corner, and select Student Portfolio



9. The list of report cards will display. Tap the desired report card to view it.
