These norms were established by the ÉGM SPC to create an environment conducive for successful meetings.

1. We agree to come to the meeting prepared to follow the agenda and time allotted while allowing for pockets of time to adequately discuss new business that arises from planned agenda items.
2. We agree to be active, contributing members to the conversation in the capacity to which we feel most comfortable (ie: typing in chat, emailing after meeting, talking during the meeting etc...)
3. We agree to keep an open mind during the sharing of thoughts and ideas, understanding the importance of making space for diverse perspectives and each person having their opinions considered.
4. We agree to create a welcoming sense of community by fostering the following values: having members contribute where their strengths shine, respect for all, trust & integrity, insofar as we do what we say we'll do.
5. We agree to create a collaborative sense of community by nurturing the following: asking for & offering help, embracing our mistakes as they help us to grow and celebrating our successes.
