The Louis Riel School Division recognizes that shopping for school supplies can become very expensive and time consuming for families. Once again, the Division will be doing a **Standardized School Supplies** program for the 2024-2025 school year for grades K-5 students.

What this means is that all basic school supplies will be provided by the school, and parents will no longer be required to purchase them. Parents can be assured that the supplies are of high quality, meet the specifications of the classroom teacher, and respect sustainable procurement practices.

In addition, we request that each family purchase a few more items and **label <u>EACH</u> item with a permanent marker**:

1 School bag (large enough to fit library books)
An extra change of clothes
1 Pair of Runners (Indoor –Gym) – Velcro LABELLED
1 Box of Kleenex
1 Box of large Ziplock brand bags
1 refillable water bottle (which will be brought home each day)
