Administration (15 min)

Community consultation was a success. We had great turnout. Over 100 adults and 90 children. Eileen suggested making a narrated PowerPoint presentation with a brief history of why we need a new school that can be posted to the website or played at future consultation meetings to give those who hadn't previously attended.

Parent Teacher conferences Tuesday (in person) and Thursday (virtual) – very few people have signed up for virtual, so it has been opened up for in person. There is some confusion as to whether to bring your child or not – it is up to the child's teacher.

Next Family Night – There will be a follow up to the recent school consultation family night in January – the school will take care of planning it.

<u>Hot Lunch:</u> Meghan gave report on progress. They looked into a variety of options. Munch a Lunch has a \$300 annual fee to participate. Healthy Hunger appears to be the best option at this time. Meghan created an account with Health Hunger. Would like to plan it for before the Christmas break if possible – Meghan to call Amy on Thursday, November 24 for a list of all the teachers. Will provide a hard copy order form for those families who need.

- How many people do we need to distribute the lunches? 4-5 depending on how many orders.
- What days for Hot lunch days suggestions were a Friday or whenever there is an early dismissal.
