
Glenwood School NEWSLETTER


Mission Statement

Winter Concert

We are all excited about our big performance at this year's winter concert! Our concert on **Thursday**, **December 14**, **2023** will feature the Kindergartens and all the grade 1-6 students performing a musical called, "A Holiday Moosical". A Matinee will take place on Thursday, December 14, 2023 at 10:30 am. Parents and guests are welcome to attend if you cannot make it in the evening. Our evening concert will be at 7:00 pm in the Glenwood School gym. Students are asked to arrive at school at 6:30 pm. When the doors open, we ask that all students and audience members remain for the duration of the show. Everyone has worked very hard for our big show, and we look forward to having a full

audience. Students will be dismissed from their classrooms at the end of the concert.

Please note: - Grade 6/7 Leray and Grade 7/8 Jordan/Hartleb are not participating in this concert. They will have their own concert in late January/February 2024 (like last school year).

What to Wear: All students (K-6) are asked to wear traditional concert dress - plain white top and black bottom. The white top need not be a dress shirt or blouse, although "logo-free" if possible. The black bottom may be anything black – dress pants, skirts, jeans or sweats. Also, black footwear would be preferable, but we do not expect families to go out to purchase anything for the concert as we recognize these are tight times for many. The white and black outfit need not be worn during the daytime for the matinee, only for the evening concert.

Parking: Parking in and around the school is limited as most of our staff will also be in attendance. A reminder to be aware of any parking bans that may be in effect at the time of the concert and that the Community Club often has evening programming and so that lot will not be available. I encourage parents to carpool or walk to the concert if possible.

Universal Access: If you need any assistance accessing the building or will need priority parking or seating, please contact the school office at 204-233-3619 before 4:00 pm on December 13th so that we can have this arranged in advance.

Pick-Up: At the end of the concert, please pick up your child at their classroom. Students will not be dismissed from the gym.

Hamper Contributions: If you would like to donate any non-perishable food items or new unwrapped toys, you are welcome to do so at the concert to help support our Community Hamper Food Drive that the school is currently working on.

Lunch Programs: Allergens

There are children attending Glenwood School who have allergies to peanut butter and nuts that can cause a severe anaphylactic reaction. Even exposure to a tiny amount of this item could be potentially serious and life threatening.

It is a goal of our school community to strive to provide a safe environment for all our students. To this end, we have reviewed the individual needs of our students and the procedures and policies presently in place. We can all play a role in preventing such a dangerous and frightening situation at school. Although specific children and families must take responsibility to avoid exposure, we can also help to make the school environment safer.

We therefore ask your co-operation in:

- Avoid sending all snacks or items containing peanuts/nuts with your child to school including food, snacks, or chips cooked in peanut oil.
- Informing your child's teacher before giving food products to any children, other than your own at school.

Any student/family who forgets and brings peanut butter/nuts to school will be asked to eat their lunch in a designated area. We will then ensure that the tables in this area are properly washed and sterilized. A reminder note will be sent home to remind parents of the importance of maintaining a nut free environment.

It is imperative that we all teach children to respect this very serious situation and discourage teasing or threatening of the allergic child. Thank you in advance for your consideration and support in this matter. As a school team, we do our utmost to ensure the safety of all students.

Student Absences and Early Pick UP

Please call the school office if your child is going to be absent or late. Office hours are 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. An answering machine is available for you to leave a message if it is more convenient for you to call outside of office hours.

If a student is absent and the parent or guardian has not called the school, we will call home or work to determine that the child's absence is known and that he/she is safe. This pertains to all grades from K to Gr. 8 and includes those days when Junior High students are to be at Industrial Arts or Home Economics classes. Please call us if your child is going to be absent, as this saves both a great deal of time and worry! Thanks!

Any student arriving after 9:00 am and 12:45 pm must report to the office upon arrival, otherwise the student will be reported absent, and an unnecessary telephone call will be made to the parent.

Occasionally parents wish to pick up their children prior to our regular dismissal times. Parents are asked to make arrangements to come into the school and pick up their children at the office. Please do not ask your child to wait at the door, or on the playground, or go to the classroom.
