5. Administration Report

○ Professional development

- Next year new curriculum K-10 in Science – consultant to be working with Science teachers on what the curriculum looks like. Leveraging Wed collaborative time to discuss.
- French teachers library (USB) – coming to work with teachers to work on increasing Indigenous voices, broader voices throughout course material.
- Math group doing follow-up work with physio and occupational therapists in the division who may have needs to ensure classes are responsive to diverse needs.
- Report card writing – developing increased consistency in marking.
- TCIS – divisional training approach (trauma crisis intervention systems) – being more responsive given kids come to school with a wide variety of life experience so ensuring staff are as responsive as possible in school environment. Throughout entire division but EAs and social services students getting a more detailed training.
