

Nordale Lunch Program Information 2026-2027

The Nordale School lunch program provides a safe, supervised environment for students who remain at school during the lunch hour. Students eat lunch in their classrooms under staff supervision and are expected to follow school expectations for respectful and responsible behaviors. The fee is \$90.00 dollars and can be paid on-line or at opening day conferences in 2 instalments. The fee helps cover the cost of lunch-hour supervision. Tax receipts are issued for the program fees and are available on the parent portal. (Students who ride the bus stay at school for lunch and are not required to pay the lunch program fee. It will be waived.)

Grade 7 and 8 students who walk to school are encouraged to go home for lunch. Students who choose to stay at school during the lunch hour are asked to be registered in the lunch program and pay the annual fee of \$90.00.

Also, students in grades 7 and 8 wishing to leave our school grounds for any reason during lunch will require a note from a parent/guardian for each occurrence, unless the yearly permission to leave school property form is signed at opening day conferences.

Weather Conditions and staying for Lunch

Please ensure that your child is properly dressed for **all** weather conditions. The Louis Riel School Division will monitor wind chill values for the purpose of safety to children. Current weather conditions are posted on the Louis Riel School Division website.

Students may be allowed outside for a maximum of 15 minutes when the wind chill reaches -27°C. Students will not be allowed outside for lunch when the wind chill reaches -30°C.
