





<b>March 1</b>	Zero Discrimination Day	Highlights how people can become informed about and promote inclusion, compassion, peace and, above all, a movement for change.
<b>March 3</b>	Hinamatsuri/ Doll's Day/ Girl's Day	A day to celebrate female children and pray for their continued health and happiness in Japan. Families display ceramic dolls dressed in the ornate, decorative robes of the ancient imperial court.
<b>March 8</b>	International Women's Day	A day celebrating the social, economic, cultural, and political achievements of women.
<b>March 17</b>	St. Patrick's Day	Saint Patrick's Day is a cultural and religious celebration held on the death date of Saint Patrick, the foremost patron saint of Ireland.
<b>March 20 or 21</b>	Kurdish Newroz	Newroz is the Kurdish celebration of the Persian new year holiday "Nowruz." Over the years, Newroz has come to represent new beginnings, as well as an opportunity to support the Kurdish cause.
<b>March 21</b>	International Day for the Elimination of Racial Discrimination	Observed annually, it commemorates the day police in Sharpeville, South Africa, opened fire and killed 69 people at a peaceful demonstration against apartheid "pass laws" in 1960.
<b>March/April</b>	Laylat al-Qadr	The night in which the Qur'an was revealed to the Prophet Muhammad
