Welcome Acting Principal Shelly Hopper

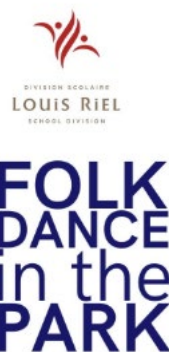
Ms. Ryz will be away on a brief leave. During her absence, we are fortunate to have **Shelly Hopper** joining us as **Acting Principal**.
