#### **New Students & New Darwin School Families**

We have welcomed over 70 new students to Darwin School this year and our global village continues to grow stronger. Our kindergarten class is winning with respect to class size sitting at 13 students and it's always special to see the younger siblings of current and former Darwin School students get to make their start in school! We have welcomed 26 students from Dr. D.W. Penner School at the grade seven level. This is the highest number of students from Dr. D.W. Penner School to join us and we want to wish them all the best as they finish their middle school experience at Darwin School.

We continue to welcome students from the LRSD International Student Program and this year we have new families from Ecuador and China. In addition, we have also welcomed several newcomer families from Uganda, China, Dubai, Ukraine, and Colombia.

In addition to students / families moving to Winnipeg from other countries, we have welcomed students from northern Manitoba, Alberta, British Columbia, from various other metro school divisions in Winnipeg, the private school system, and our own French Immersion program in LRSD.

We currently have 288 students enrolled at Darwin School for the 2023-2024 school year!
