## Student Absences

- When as student will be absence, parents/caregivers are required to notify the school.
- Families can choose to call (204) 255-7880 (leave a message after hours) or email [wyatt.office@lrsd.net](mailto:wyatt.office@lrsd.net)
- Your support in reporting absences will help to reduce our daily call rate for absent students and help to ensure student safety.

## Student Lates

- When a student arrives to school after 9:00 a.m., they must come through the front doors and report to the service window off the office for a late slip.
- If a student will be arriving after 9:00 a.m., we encourage families to contact the school so that we can greet them at the front doors as our doors will be locked throughout the day.

## School Supplies Fee: \$40.00

- Required for all students.
- School fees are due and payable by **Friday, October 11<sup>th</sup>, 2024.**
- Please pay for fees with one cheque per family.
- A cheque is the preferred form of payment to avoid lost or misplaced cash between home and school.
- Remember to include the student's first and last name and grade on the cheque.
- Parents wishing to pay with cash can do so in the office during school hours.
- All cheques are payable to Victor H. L. Wyatt School.

## Lunch Fees: \$90.00

- Students who are able to eat lunch at home during the school year are recommended to do so.
- The lunch fees for students who must stay for lunch are **\$90.00** for the school year, which can be paid as follows:
  - School Cash Website:
    - Various payment options available (full payment, monthly, etc.)
  - Cash or cheque:
    - 1 full payment - \$90.00 due October 11<sup>th</sup> or
    - 2 split payments - \$45.00 for September to January due October 11<sup>th</sup> and \$45.00 for February to June due March 7<sup>th</sup>.
    - Alternate payment plan can be arranged through the office.
- For students who need to stay for lunch once in a while, there will be a \$1.00 per day lunch fee.
- Grade 7 and 8 students are expected to go home for lunch. However, if a grade 7 and 8 student needs to regularly stay for lunch parents/ guardians must contact the office.

***\*Please note that food is not included in the lunch program. The cost of the fees are for student supervision only.***

## Early Dismissal

- Early dismissal (2:30 p.m.) will occur on the fourth Tuesday of every month to accommodate our divisional, school-based Staff Meetings.
- Our first early dismissal will be on Tuesday, September 26th.
- Please be on time for pick-ups to enable us to begin our Staff Meeting in a timely manner.
