- Question to Karen: Is there adequate resources i.e. technology for the students? Yes, there is right now for school use. The students had their own last year due to the Edwin pilot project. This is not occurring this year as the division chose not to continue with this project. There are carts with class sets of laptops to be shared by classrooms.

The issue is we must have money to match the grants. Itoro emailed our school trustees (Pam Kolochuk and Tom Parker). The response from Pam Kolochuk is that LRSD does not provide money for playground enhancement.

Maybe we could focus on something else. I.e. helping with field trip costs? If anyone else has any other ideas please bring them forward.
