During the school year, your child will be using books and materials supplied by the Louis Riel School Division. The school has no caution fee. However, parents and students must assume financial responsibility for the loss of or damage to school books.

- 1 School Bag
- 1 Lunch kit (for children having lunch at school)
- 1 Reusable water bottle (to be kept at school)
- 1 Pair of headphones in a small Ziploc bag
- 1 Oversized shirt for painting
- 1 Deck of playing cards
- Pair of runners for **indoor** use only (non-marking soles, no skater shoes)
- 1 3-ring binder with zipper enclosure for Music
- 1 Yamaha Baroque Soprano Recorder to be purchased from École Guyot for \$6.00 for those who don't have one from a sibling to use
- 1 École Guyot zippered cloth homework bag or \$4.00 if a new one is required

** Please make sure that your child's name is clearly printed on all items. **

We ask that your child always have a change of clothes (shorts/pants & t-shirt) in their backpack in case of accidents (juice, mud, etc.)

Students will be required to pay a \$40.00 fee for school supplies (payable to École Guyot).

Please note this fee will cover all the following supplies: pencils, pens, erasers, glue, paper, duotangs, scissors, binders, highlighters and art supplies.

Physical Education

All students must wear runners that offer good support and traction. Spiral or flat laces are recommended as round shoelaces come undone easily which affects safety and participation. Please assist your child in becoming proficient at tying laces securely. We do not allow the use of sandals, flip flops, skater shoes or any shoes that mark the gym floor. This pair of runners will remain at school and will be exclusively for indoor use. The same pair of runners can be used for both the classroom and physical education classes.

Lunch

The school requires a sturdy lunch box for all students that have lunch at school. The child's lunch box should be clearly marked with his/her name. **Thank you!**
