GUIDELINES

Children who stay at Glenwood for lunch will be supervised by adult employees of the Louis Riel School Division. Students will eat lunch in the building from 11:45am - 12:15pm, and will go outside along with the supervisors from 12:15pm - 12:45pm for the remainder of the lunch hour.

Students will be going outside for Lunch recess according to School Division guidelines. Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather conditions. Indoor recess is generally called during rain or at temperatures below -30C. If children stay inside, the Lunch Program staff will provide activities for the students.

Expectations regarding behavior in the lunch program are the same as the expectations we have for students at any other time of the school day. Students are expected to treat the facilities and other people with respect and to follow the rules of the lunch program.

- All students in grades 1-6 staying for lunch must complete the form overleaf.
- Students in grades 7 & 8 are required to go home for lunch.
- There will be no sharing of lunches between students.

PAYMENT
