<b>5.</b>	<b>School Report (Jennifer Oldfield)</b>  New at Van B :  We'd like to welcome Brett Desrochers, who is an Educational Assistant with us during Denise Acres' absence. We have also hired a replacement for Mme Jessica in 2/3 – we are just giving her the opportunity to announce  Students and staff did a wonderful job with our Remembrance Day ceremony. I was so impressed with how all students behaved during the ceremony, and with the students who emceed and sang.

	<p>Our Roots of Empathy programming began in Mme Courtney’s class this month. It’s wonderful to see the students interacting with and learning from baby Annie.</p> <p>All staff have been engaging in training around Therapeutic Crisis Intervention (teaching and interacting with a trauma-informed lens) – this is either taking place over three PD days or in an intensive one-day format, depending on the role.</p> <p>Our hearing and vision screening took place yesterday for our youngest students.</p> <p>We’re in the midst of planning a food drive for next week. We’ll have suggested items for each day of the week, and that information will go home by Friday.</p> <p>We received a quote for soccer nets and some volleyballs to use outdoors. (\$979.60 was the Quote)</p> <p>School Safety: As of tomorrow morning, we are moving toward a locked door system, whereby visitors will eventually be buzzed in by a video monitoring system. As a temporary measure while we wait for that system to be installed, we have had a doorbell installed at the front door.
