6	School Report (Jennifer) Staffing update: - We have hired Mme Krista Pickering – currently at École Guyot – to replace Michelle Follows in Student Services. - It was such a delight to see all of our students perform at our Spring concert in April. Using ATC as a facility for K-6 seemed like a good choice, particularly because it meant having two shows rather than three. We are looking at booking again at ATC for next year's December show. - We are celebrating I Love to Read month in May this year, with a fun whole-school reading bingo activity that will be happening throughout the month. Classes do a variety of activities on the bingo card, take a photo of them in action, and add it to our Bingo bulletin board at the entrance. - Our grade 7 and 8 students are very busy this month – today was a frosty first track and field meet with two more to come, and next week will hopefully be much warmer for our two days at Camp Manitou. - We received a quote for jerseys – these would be used by our grade 5/6 students for any sporting event they would attend but would be reused by the school. The cost is 1680.00 for 60 jerseys. If this is too much for PAC to support this year, can we look at purchasing 20 or 30 jerseys now and the remainder next year? - We have a list of field trips that required bussing this year. - Work on our pollinator garden project is advancing. We have received some money from the division for materials, and divisional Elder Chickadee will join the committee Friday to share teachings and guidance around the project.
