I. POLICY

The Louis Riel School Division was established on July 19, 2002, by order of the Minister of Education of the Province of Manitoba by virtue of the authority vested in the minister by Section 7 of the Manitoba Public Schools Act.

The Louis Riel School Division is a legal body corporate and political sub-division of the Province of Manitoba with powers and duties as outlined in the <u>Manitoba Public Schools Act</u> and its <u>regulations</u>.

The Louis Riel School Division received Qualified Donees Status on March 16, 2017 from Canada Revenue Agency, enabling the Division to issue official donation receipts, and receive gifts from registered charities.

II. GUIDELINES

- A. The Louis Riel School Division was formed by the amalgamation of St. Boniface School Division No. 4 and St. Vital School Division No. 6, as stated by Manitoba Regulation 116/2002.
- B. The Division's description and its Ward boundaries are shown in the Director of Surveys Plan 20157 on record in the Department of Education in the City of Winnipeg.

III. PROCEDURES

- A. The Division is governed by nine (9) trustees.
- B. The Division comprises four (4) electoral wards. Wards I, 2, and 4 are each represented by two (2) trustees. Ward 3 is represented by three (3) trustees.
- C. The general business of the Division is conducted at the Louis Riel School Division Office, 900 St. Mary's Road, Winnipeg, MB R2M 3R3.
