ORIENTATION OF NEWLY-ELECTED TRUSTEES	BIA

I. POLICY

The Louis Riel School Board believes that the role of the Trustee compels attention to supporting newly-elected Trustees' successful transition to that role. Accordingly, such support must include newly-elected Trustees' reception of information pertinent to activities of the Board as defined by

- The Public Schools Act
- <u>Policy AD</u> Educational Philosophy: Vision, Mission, Values & Motto
- Policy ADE Multi-Year Strategic Planning Process
- Procedural By-Laws of the Louis Riel School Division Board of Trustees
- The GUIDELINES of this policy

Accordingly, the Board expects that newly-elected Trustees shall avail themselves of opportunities to receive this information.

II. GUIDELINES

- A. The Chair of the School Board and the Superintendent of Schools shall invite newly-elected Trustees to attend sessions.
- B. The orientation process for newly-elected Trustees shall include provision of information about the following elements:
 - Pertinent provincial legislation
 - The <u>Manitoba School Boards Association (MSBA)</u>, its orientation session for new Trustees and other pertinent professional development activities
 - General orientation to the <u>LRSD Policy Manual</u> with attention to the following sections:
 - o A: Foundations and Basic Commitments
 - o B: School Board Governance and Operations
 - C: General School Administration
 - o D: Fiscal Management
 - o G: Personnel
 - The current Board Budget and the development process

- 2. The Chair of the School Board and the Superintendent of Schools shall invite newly-elected Trustees to a meeting to discuss this policy.
