RECOGNITION OF SERVICE OF TRUSTEES	BID

I. POLICY

In keeping with its practices to recognize other people who have contributed their services to the Louis Riel School Division, the Board wishes to recognize its members upon their retirement, or at the end of their terms of office, for their contributions:

- to the students, employees and citizens of the Division;
- to the Board as a corporate entity; and
- to the public education system.

II. GUIDELINE

The tangible recognition given to Trustees on their retirement, or at the end of their terms of office, shall consider their length of service.

III. PROCEDURES

1. The Superintendent of Schools in consultation with the Chair and Vice-Chair shall initiate the procedures for recognition of Trustees who retire or complete their terms of office.
2. An appropriate motion expressing appreciation to Trustees who retire or complete their terms of office shall be placed in the Board Minutes.
