Qualifications:

- Class II Driver's Licence
- School Bus Driver's Certificate
- First Aid and CPR Certificate
- Five years practical driving experience

Completion of Louis Riel School Division Bus Driver Training Program and Epi-pen Administration Training

CUSTODIAN

Custodians in their work provide welcoming and safe learning and working environments in our schools and divisional buildings.

Positions include Head Custodian, Custodian, and Custodial Aide. The duties, responsibilities and the post-secondary education are specific to each job.

Qualifications:

- Valid Manitoba 5th Class Power Engineering Certificate required for Head Custodian position
- Knowledge of WHMIS
- Ability to operate power and manual cleaning equipment and tools
- Related work experience
