Art Workshop on May 1, 2025 - Developing Creative Imagination for Students

We are pleased to announce that the Creative Foundation will host this year's creative art workshop for students in grades 6–10 on Thursday, May 1, 2025, from 9:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The venue is Event Hall 1, Dakota Community Centre, 1188 Dakota Street. The workshop will be facilitated by Winnipeg-based artist and inventor of Remoglue technique, Yisa Akinbolaji. He will teach students about the importance of originality and how to create using his innovative Remoglue technique. The cost is \$10.

Yisa, renowned for his groundbreaking technique, has years of experience conducting workshops for students and professionals. Yisa was featured on the cover of *Art Business News*, New York in 2011 after his exhibition in Remoglue technique. Yisa who holds a Master of Fine Arts, is a former college and high school art educator. He served as the past president of the *Manitoba Society of Artists* and was a member of board of the *Manitoba Arts Council* of nine years.

During the upcoming workshop, students will create artworks using Remoglue (short for removable glue) on a canvas H10" x W8 during the session. The Creative Foundation will supply all necessary materials; however, students may only take their finished artworks with them. Unused materials will remain at the location after the workshop.
