## Art Workshop on May 1, 2025 - Developing Creative Imagination for Students

We are pleased to announce that the Creative Foundation will host this year's creative art workshop for students in **grades 6 –10** on **Thursday, May 1, 2025, from 9:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.** The venue is Event Hall 1, **Dakota Community Centre**, 1188 Dakota Street. The workshop will be facilitated by Winnipeg-based artist and inventor of **Remoglue technique**, Yisa Akinbolaji. He will teach students about the importance of originality and how to create using his innovative Remoglue technique. **The cost is \$10.**

Yisa, renowned for his groundbreaking technique, has years of experience conducting workshops for students and professionals. Yisa was featured on the cover of *Art Business News*, New York in 2011 after his exhibition in Remoglue technique. Yisa who holds a Master of Fine Arts, is a former college and high school art educator. He served as the past president of the *Manitoba Society of Artists* and was a member of board of the *Manitoba Arts Council* of nine years.

During the upcoming workshop, students will create artworks using Remoglue (short for removable glue) on a canvas H10" x W8 during the session. The Creative Foundation will supply all necessary materials; however, students may only take their finished artworks with them. Unused materials will remain at the location after the workshop. 
