I. POLICY

The Louis Riel School Division recognizes its fiduciary and pedagogical responsibility to monitor, and review regularly, divisional programming to maximize effective use of divisional resources. Divisional programming is all educational opportunities that the Division's students have within Louis Riel School Division. This programming can include but is not limited to; Individualized programming, Modified programming, Adapted programming, Language programming and programming for specialized needs.

Accordingly, the Division supports an effectively planned review process as an important strategy for

- supporting the Division's Mission and Vision for student learning;
- providing recommendations that support program improvement;
- determining the level of financial support necessary to support program improvement;
- identifying future priorities and divisional program initiatives.

II. GUIDELINES

A divisional programming review will respect the following principles:

1. Research and consultation processes shall respect;
 - ethical research practices, including all necessary observations of confidentiality protocols and appropriate data collection and analysis procedures;
 - the nature, complexity and scope of the program under review.
2. The timing and duration of the review shall occur with respect to the context of other divisional priorities and be appropriate to the nature, complexity and scope of the programming under review.
3. The Superintendent of Schools or designate shall determine the process for the review of new programming opportunities.

III. PROCEDURES

1. The Superintendent of Schools has the authority and responsibility to present, for the Board's consideration and approval, proposal(s) for program review processes that include purpose, structure, terms of reference, and associated costs and schedules for all aspects of the proposed review.

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2. The Superintendent of Schools or designate(s) is responsible for;
 - implementing the programming review proposal
 - presenting any resultant recommendations within timelines
3. The Board shall have definitive ownership of all information gathered during the review process.

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
