ACCOMMODATIONS FOR REQUIRED INSTRUCTION	IMBB

I. POLICY

The Louis Riel School Division respects that ethical, religious or psychological considerations may lead parents to request a reasonable accommodation to meet curricular outcomes.

II. GUIDELINES

- I. Accommodations to required instruction do not excuse the student from meeting the required outcomes of the curriculum or from the requirements for graduation.

III. PROCEDURES

1. To receive such an accommodation, the parents/guardians must present a written request with documentation for an accommodation to the Principal, stating the contradiction(s) involved. This request must come within one week of when the exemption for instruction is required. If this request involves an accommodation for Physical Education, a medical note may be required.
2. Once the Principal approves a request for an accommodation for instruction, reasonable accommodation in the curriculum shall be made for the student. Any alternative instruction shall be approved in advance by the Principal in consultation with the appropriate teacher and shall meet the outcome requirements of the curriculum that is being replaced.
3. Principals may consult with the Superintendent (or designate) for assistance if the need arises.
