### I. POLICY

The Louis Riel School Division recognizes the educational and cultural value of international students and student exchange programs. The International Student Program supports the admission of international students to the regular educational programs offered within the school division subject to meeting the conditions of admission established for the requested program.

In addition, the Division supports international cultural enrichment programs as an opportunity for students to develop an appreciation for: International culture, traditions, languages and lifestyles, international interdependence and cooperation, the importance of diplomacy, its processes, protocols and benefits, as well as Canada's role in the global community and Canada's cultural diversity and heritage.

### II. GUIDELINES

The International Student Program (ISP) is accredited and a member of Imagine Canada, Canada Association of Public Schools-International (CAPS-I) and Manitoba Council for International Education (MCIE). Within this program the Division offers:

1. Summer Enrichment Program
2. Full Year and Semester Programs
3. Post-Secondary Technical/Vocational Program
4. Cultural Enrichment Program

The approval of all the above-mentioned programs is at the discretion of the Superintendent of Schools or designate.
