Re: Launch of the Manitoba K-12 Education Data Dashboard

We are pleased to announce the launch of the Manitoba K-12 Education Data Dashboard, a revisualization of publicly accessible provincial high school graduation rates and student achievement statistics.

In early 2024, Manitoba Education and Early Childhood Learning began work on developing education data dashboards to enhance data-driven decision making aimed at improving educational outcomes. The Manitoba K-12 Education Data Dashboard is the first iteration of this initiative. It provides accessible data that supports an understanding of student achievement statistics and is available on the department's website at www.edu.gov.mb.ca/k12/grad rates/index.html.

The revisualization of student achievement statistics allows users to view data in a more modern, dynamic and in-depth format, making it easier for users to navigate and understand key educational outcomes. This data includes Kindergarten's *Early Development Instrument*, the *Grade 3 and 4 Assessment*, the *Middle Years Assessment*, Grade 9 credit attainment statistics, Grade 12 provincial test average scores, and Manitoba's student-tracked high school graduation rates.
