Principal's Report/School News- Rick Rajotte

- Butterfly Garden- the students designed it. The kids created a walkway through the garden. We
 decided to move the rocks around the garden. The rocks signify the 12 hours. We grow plants to
 attract butterflies.
 - The space became much bigger, which increased the cost. We planted the garden so it would grow over summer. The Day Care was in charge of watering the plants, but with all the rain they didn't have to water much after all. Next spring we are going to grow the plants from seed in the school. PAC we will put up a plaque to acknowledge the contributions to the creation of the garden..
- 125 students in our school this year!!! Last year 131. 25 kids in Kindergarten!!! We actually only have two new students in the school. Last year this time we had 18 new students.
- Cross Country running club. Students 4-6. Three track meets. Great participation at the races!! The practices are all on lunch hour.
- Lunch program has changed slightly- students eat lunch in their rooms.
- All of our rooms now have a function to them. One is used for sensory and movement needs. One
 classroom used for work with staff to work with students. One room is a divisional EAL program. All
 the rooms in the school are now occupied.
- Mad Science- Being offered again!!! Program offered students 1-6. Afterschool program cost approx. \$80. Over half of our students signed up last year. This will be offered after January.
