There are 20 different native languages spoken among the enrolled students. There will be changes in the way the school will communicate with these students and their families. Letters will be translated into different

- languages to ensure that families understand the information being sent out. This will be a learning year in determining the most helpful and effective ways to support our EAL students and families.
