Who we are:

Samuel Burland is a community of 470 students and 50 staff. The school opened in 1987 and grew up with the River Park South community. We now serve the second generation as many current parents attended Samuel Burland as students. The diversity of our students continues to evolve; 102 students speak one of 21 languages other than English as their first language. The 32 teachers that work at Samuel Burland have an average experience of just under 18 years.

Priority - Literacy

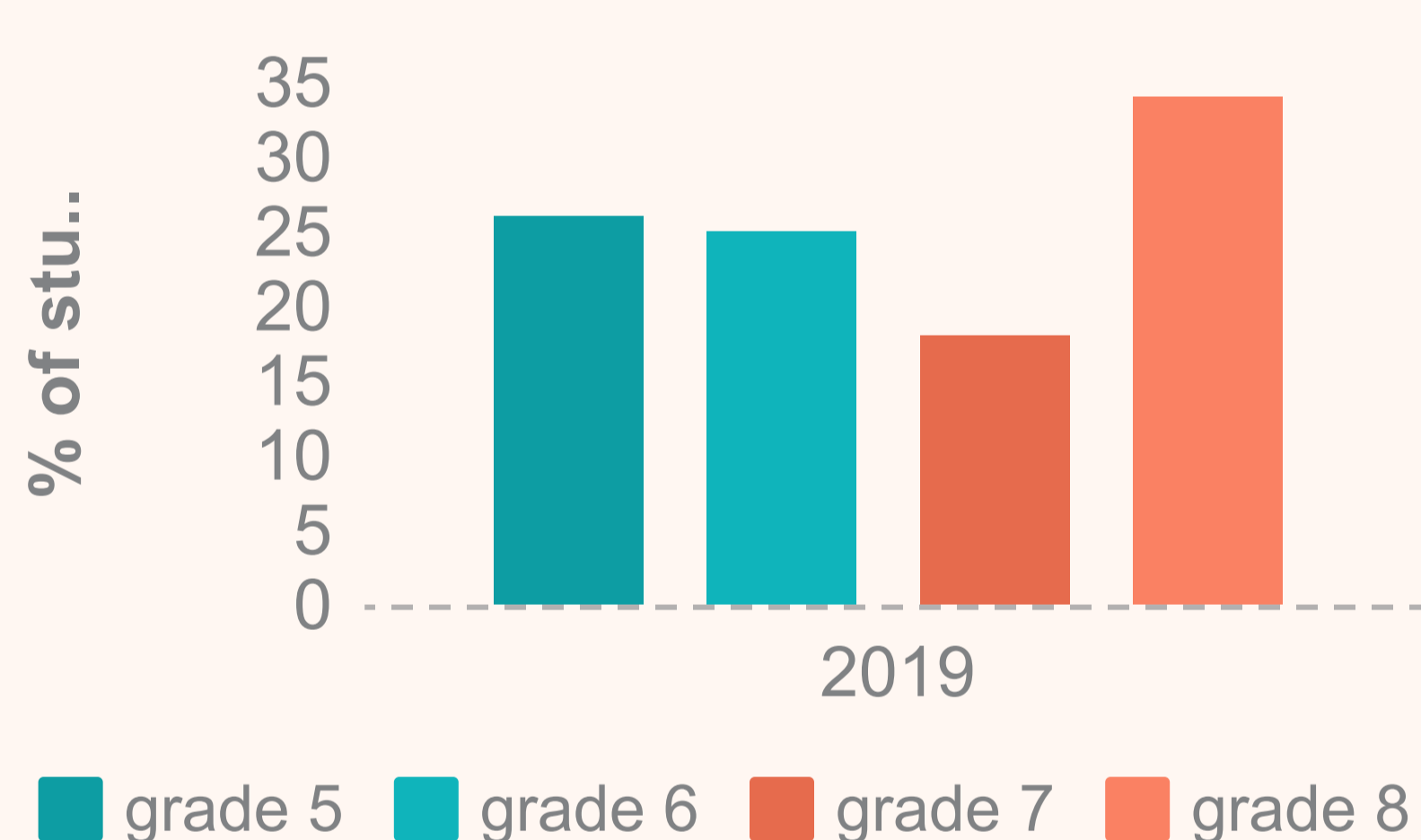
We view Literacy as a foundational skill. Our goal is for all learners to meet or exceed their Literacy learning goals.
