## 2025 Summer Enrichment Program

### Overview

The LRSD 2025 Summer Enrichment Program offers a 2-4-week immersive experience for international students to explore Canadian culture and enrich their educational journey.

This program aims to enhance academic learning by providing grade 7-12 international students with essential skills, cultural insights, and enduring academic knowledge that will benefit them beyond their time in Canada.

# Why LRSD Go Global Summer Enrichment Program?



## Enhanced Educational Experience:

Enhancing the academic journey of international students during their stay in Canada.



## Beyond Classroom Learning:

Providing experiential learning opportunities that extend beyond traditional academic settings.



## Cultural Exploration:

Offering insights into Canadian culture, particularly within the Winnipeg area and its surroundings.



**English Language Proficiency:**  
Creating an environment conducive to practicing and improving English language skills.

Facilitating interaction and collaboration with Canadian peers and educators.



# LRSD Go Global Summer Enrichment Program Features

Participants in the LRSD Summer Enrichment Program can anticipate a comprehensive range of activities and benefits:

## Cultural Enrichment

Participating in cultural activities and excursions deepens students' understanding and fosters appreciation of Canadian society.

## Language Development

English language practice opportunities enhance students' language proficiency in school settings and cultural excursions.

## Academic Excellence

Classes are taught by certified Canadian teachers, fostering an inclusive environment for learning and growth.

## Academic Credit

Completing the 4-week program earns participants a high school credit in English as an Additional Language (EAL) from Manitoba.

## Certificate of Completion

Every participant will receive recognition for their accomplishments during the summer.

## Accommodation Option

The program offers a homestay option for those interested, allowing participants a more immersive cultural experience.

## Welcoming Arrival

LRSD homestay students will be welcomed upon arrival at the airport.

# **LRSD Go Global Summer Enrichment Program**

## **Weekly Themes**

This summer program is a two to four-week-long course designed to provide participants with a well-rounded understanding of Canadian culture, history, and lifestyle.

# LRSD Go Global Summer Enrichment Program Activities

Each day starts with academic activities led by certified teachers and supported by high school student volunteers. After academics, students will engage in field trips and hands-on activities.

## Sample Activities

- **Identity Flag:** Students will create unique flags that represent their interests, ideas, and personal traits.
- **Currency Unit:** Students will explore the concept of Canadian currency and take a guided tour of the Canadian Mint.
- **French Community:** A walking visit to St. Boniface will highlight its many attractions and showcase the significance of the French community to Winnipeg and Canada.
- **Canadian Citizenship:** An introduction to key concepts of Canadian citizenship, including democratic values and responsibilities.
